Murder in Cleveland – a photography exhibit by Shawn Mishak & Jay Brown

Adshade won the People’s Choice Award last summer at the Toronto Outdoor Art Exhibition.

Paul Evans – designer & sculptor

Pieces from Evans' "Cityscape" series. A designer and sculptor, Paul Evans (USA, 1931-1987) was a wild card of late 20th century modernism. A leading light of the American Studio Furniture movement, Evans’s work manifests a singular aesthetic sense, as well as a seemingly contradictory appreciation for both “folk art” forms and for new materials and technologies.
